



# Dulles League Rules and Regulations

Thank you for being a part of The Dulles Cornhole League for the upcoming Season. As we continue to grow and improve our League, we have updated our rules and regulations.

## 1. First and foremost!

We are a competitive cornhole league that is very social. Our members understand that it is about having fun, not taking any game too seriously, and having great competition. The league is split into a Competitive Division and Social Division.

## 2. League Rules Committee:

- a. We have established a rules committee to assist in defining and re-defining the League Rules and Regulations. The 5-person committee is made up of the 3 League organizers and 2 other League members.
- b. The committee will vote on any League matters that come into question, including, but not exclusive to, a team being too strong for the Competitive Division or the Social Division, the use of a sub for playoffs and more. The vote is by majority for all issues.

## 3. Competitive Division:

- a. The Competitive Division will have a maximum **combined** Team Points Per Round (PPR) of **15.7**.
  - i. Each player PPR will be established from each players Scoreholio 120 Day PPR. If a player is new to Scoreholio and does not have a 120 Day PPR, they will be required to provide a screen shot of their current PPR on the last date of the league\*. If either player is unable to provide a recent PPR, then the League Rules Committee will vote as to if the team may be paired in the upcoming season.
    1. Last Date of League = The 6<sup>th</sup> week or final playoffs of the season.
- b. Any team that wins the Competitive Division playoffs will be required to split for a minimum of two(2) seasons.

## 4. Social Division

- a. The Social Division will have a maximum **combined** Team Points Per Round (PPR) of **12.7**.
  - i. Each player PPR will be established from each players Scoreholio 120 Day PPR. If a player is new to Scoreholio and does not have a 120 Day PPR, they will be required to provide a screen shot of their current PPR on the last date of the league\*. If either player is unable to provide a recent PPR, then the League Rules Committee will vote as to if the team may be paired in the upcoming season.
    1. Last Date of League = The 6<sup>th</sup> week or final playoffs of the season.
    2. No one player may have an individual PPR of more than 7.5.
- b. Any team that wins the Social Division playoffs will be required to either split and partner with another player or move up to the Competitive Division for the next season they play.

### 5. Basic Rules:

- a. Substitutes: Any player can sub during the regular season.
  - i. A team may not have a substitute with a higher PPR than their partners more than one (1) time during the season.
  - ii. NO DOUBLE SUBS. One team member must be present at each game in order to utilize a sub.
- b. Substitutes in the Playoffs: If a sub is needed in the playoffs, the sub must not have a higher recent PPR than the person they are replacing. If the sub cannot provide a recent PPR, then the League Rules Committee will vote if the sub would be permitted. This rule applies to both Competitive & Social Divisions.
  - i. All substitutes in the playoffs MUST BE APPROVED by the rules committee. No Exceptions.
- c. Time-outs are permitted but will be held to a maximum of 20 seconds.
- d. **Rule on Short/Draper Bags.** If a bag is thrown short of the board and laying on the ground, it is the Throwers Option/Choice to remove the bag or keep it where it lies. Exception: If it is deemed that the bag is interfering with game play (i.e. leaning half on the board but touching the ground). Note: *If an opponent moves the short bag prematurely and interferes with the thrower, the thrower will have a choice to re-throw.*
- e. **NEW-Stepping Over Line.** The ACL has recently changed/updated the rule on players stepping over the line. A player may not step over the line at any point when throwing the bag. This includes the follow through and after the bag is out of hand.
